

Half day Casertas' Realm with drop off in Rome

Private luxury car with English speaking driver will pick you up at the designed location and lead you to the Casertas' Realm and surrounding area for a one day excursion of this 18th-Century Royal Palace with the Park, the Aqueduct of Vanvitelli, and the San Leucio Complex.

The monumental complex at Caserta, created by the Bourbon king Charles III in the mid-18th century to rival Versailles and the Royal Palace in Madrid, is exceptional for the way in which it brings together a magnificent palace with its park and gardens, as well as natural woodland, hunting lodges and a silk factory.

It is an eloquent expression of the Enlightenment in material form, integrated into, rather than imposed on, its natural setting and is on the world heritage list of Unesco since 1997.
