

Half day christian Rome

Your private sightseeing start at the hotel where a personal driver will pick you up and bring at Callixtus Catacomb along the Ancient Appian way. The guided visit will take about 40 mins leading you through the networks of tunnel of carved volcanic rock where the early christians buried the dead and use to have memorial services and celebrations. Then you will proceed in the direction of the papal basilica of St. John In Lateran, the oldest of the four papal major basilicas renovated by Borromini.

After a short visit you will move through St. Mary Major located in Esquilino Square and have a stop to see the highest tower bell in Rome, the beautiful mosaics and the Marian Column erected in 1614 to design of Maderno. Then moving in the direction of the house of Nero you will reach Saint Peter in Chains a Roman catholic titular church and minor basilica best known for being the home of Michelangelo's statue of Moses part of the tomb of pope Julius II, and for having the relic of the chains that bound Saint Peter when he was imprisoned in Jerusalem.
