

Tarquinia & Cerveteri Necropolis

Your personal driver will pick you up at the required location and he will bring you directly to Tarquinia an ancient city on the east coast in the province of Viterbo.

Tarquinia was one of the most powerful Etruscan cities, thanks to its strategic location nearby the sea.

Main sights are the palaces, squares and tombs. The gothic Palazzo Vitelleschi, presently the National Museum of Tarquinia, offers an excellent exhibition on Greek and Etruscan art.

The collection includes sarcophagi, vases, jewellery and in particular the terracotta statues of two winged horses circa 4 B.C.

You will visit Necropolis, Etruscan burial site, that will present you with unique and exceptional testimony to the ancient Etruscan civilization.



The Tarquinia Necropolis has been described as “the first chapter in the history of great Italian painting” for its exceptional painted tombs adorned with scenes of human life: huntsmen, fishermen, musicians, dancers, jugglers and athletes. Moving from Tarquinia your driver will bring you to Cerveteri, where you can have a lunch time on your choice (or upon suggest) and in the afternoon you will start the visit of the Cerveteri Necropolis, the most imposing in all Etruria and one of the most magnificent in the entire Mediterranean basin.





You can get lost as you wander the streets of this “city of the dead”, enter its houses and take a trip back in time, aided by the multimedia Installations that use audiovisual Projections virtual reconstructions, Sound and light effects and 3D videos to show you how the tombs would have looked more than two thousand years ago, reproducing the atmospheres of the day and the treasures they conceal. The related National Museum home to numerous Etruscan artefacts, including the celebrated Sarcophagus of the Spouses, is a world leader for its use of technology, as applied in the innovative “touch on glass” project: you touch a glass display case and archaeological artefacts thousands of years old come back to life to tell you about the history, anecdotes and secrets of the mysterious world of the Etruscans. The project puts Cerveteri up there at the top of the world’s hi-tech archaeological site rankings. At the end of the visit your driver will drive you back to the hotel.
